Romans 12: 2 (MSG)

"...[2] Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking.

Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you."

THE MOST POPULAR UNBIBLICAL WORLD-VIEWS (unbiblical isms)

- 1. **Materialism** Is a worldview that what matters in life is money.
- **2. Hedonism** is a worldview that what matters i life is <u>pleasure</u>.
- 3. Individualism or Narcissism " Me first " worldview
- 4. Pragmatism "Whatever works for you " worldview
- 5. Humanism "I am god " worldview
- **6. Atheism -** a world view that "there is no God."
- 7. Socialism "The government knows best "worldview
 - A. Atheistic and materialistic worldview.
 - B. Suffering is caused by unequal distribution of wealth.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:10 (NIV)

[10] ... "If a man will not work, he shall not eat."

- [8] But if someone does not provide for his own,12 especially his own family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

A large share of the nation's problems are directly attributed to the absence of a biblical worldview among Americans. A survey of 2033 adults only 4% has a biblical worldview.
